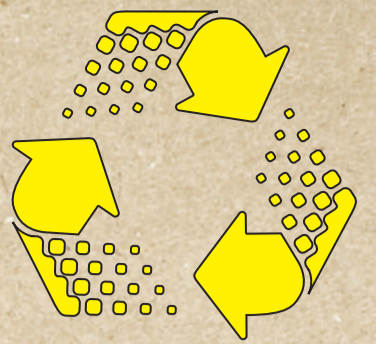

NO plastic bags All plastic bags go in your waste bin or can be recycled at your nearest major supermarket.  



NO soft plastic If you can scrunch it up, it goes in the waste bin. No plastic bags, food wrap, frozen food or bread bags - even if they say they are recyclable!  

NO polystyrene including all types of polystyrene - foam, polystyrene from packaging, bean bags, foam peanuts, polystyrene beads etc.
