Council is currently developing a Parking Strategy. Council wants to hear the community's views on how parking can be managed in the future. We are now undertaking engagement to further understand what is most important to our community.

Why do we need to think about parking?

- Climate Emergency - free and ample parking encourages personal car use.
- Limited space - our population is growing and if we don't change, we'll need to add 41,000 parking spaces by 2041
- Safety - having lots of parking around schools and other places with high activity makes it less safe for people to get around.
- Oversupply - on average 40% of off-street residential parking is vacant; we want to better match supply and demand.
- Transport - we need to change our parking management to make it easier to get around the city with better public transport, walking and cycling.
